The International Workshop NDT in Progress 2017 organized by the Czech Society for NDT (CNDT) and the Institute of Thermomechanics of the Czech Academy of Sciences under auspices of ACADEMIA NDT International and European Federation for NDT will be already 9th event in a series started in 2001 as a biennial workshops organized commonly by the German NDT society DGZfP and CNDT.

The primary aim of these popular workshops is a meeting of NDT world experts and students from both academic and industrial branches allowing them deep discussions on the latest state-of-the-art of the nondestructive testing and evaluation (NDT/NDE) research and developments in all scientific and application areas.

All interested persons are cordially invited to contribute to discussions by their oral and/or poster presentations. Next to the skilled experts, the workshop is also intended for young researchers and students who are invited to present their latest results and findings including not yet finished research. The Workshop will be exceptional opportunity for exchange of new experiences and methodologies in the NDT/NDE/SHM fields.

Besides the working days you will also have a nice occasion to enjoy Prague - one of the most magical cities in Europe.

Language:

The official language of the Workshop is English.

Main topics of the Workshop cover (not only):

- Radiographic methods; infrared & terahertz waves testing.
- Optical methods & defects imaging.
- Signal & Image processing in NDT/NDE; tomography.
- Nonlinear methods; inverse problems; time reversal.
- Structural health and condition monitoring (SHM/CM).
- Numerical simulations and modeling in NDT/NDE.
- Automated NDT systems & data handling.
- Student presentations and poster session.

Authors are invited to submit their abstracts and papers in electronic files for inclusion in the Workshop's Proceedings. Authors should follow the guidelines for abstract and paper submission available at the conference website together with the on-line registration form. Due to the character of the workshop, the number of papers for oral presentation is limited. Papers for oral presentation will be selected by the Scientific Committee. Authors of poster presentation will have an opportunity for short oral communication. Remember please the dead-line – June 30, 2017.

All authors will be notified on the acceptance of their abstracts and on presentation form until two weeks after their submission. Abstracts will be published in a Special Issue of NDT-Welding Bulletin. Full version of papers will be published in printed Proceedings and memory-stick included in conference materials. Proceedings will be available after the conference also on-line at the www.ndt.net – public-open journal ISSN 1435-4934. Printed proceedings will be proposed for indexing in the Scopus database and selected papers will be offered for publish-

Conference venue:

The workshop venue is the modern hotel Meritum located on the western part of the Prague city. It is a quiet district of Prague 6, Ruzyne between the city center and near the International Václav Havel Prague Airport. The venue is easily accessible for passengers traveling by plane or car. The hotel Meritum is invalid friendly. All hotel rooms have their own shower, WC, refrigerator, TV + Sat. and wi-fi.

The hotel includes the stylish Restaurant "U Rychtare", located in the monumentally protected object of "Kubr farm" from the 16th century, the oldest rural homestead in Prague. We recom-





mend staying there a few days before or after the workshop in Prague. The hotel reservation could be done for the dates October 7– 15, 2017. The sight-seeing programs for interested participants and accompanying persons will be organized in Prague. Regarding to the fact that Prague is a much frequented tourist center and the capacity of hotels is limited, all participants are asked to send their accommodation requests as soon as possible. All rooms will be allocated on a first come, first served basis.
